Little Sprout Camp at the Treehouse at WLC

Our Little Sprout Camp is our toddler-preschool summer program. It is an enrichment program where children can enjoy the outdoors and nature in our playground, experiment with water and ice in our outdoor sensory tables and enjoy hands-on activities, crafts, music, and stories in our air-conditioned classrooms. All the activities for this camp are carefully planned with the “first time” camper in mind.

Treehouse Camp at WLC

Our Treehouse Camp is the perfect camp for children in preschool through kindergarten. It is an enrichment program where children will explore nature and the outdoors on our playground, by using the outdoor sensory tables for some fun hands on activities. Campers will also utilize our air-conditioned classroom space for crafts, music, movement & more!

Camp Details

Little Sprout and Treehouse camps run 9-12 for ½ day camp and 9-3 for full day camp during all summer sessions. You can choose an enrollment option that fits your child’s need: 2 days, 3 days or 5 days per week. Each week both camps will explore a theme, with a fun and exciting theme-launch “Special Event” on Mondays! Is your child not signed up to attend on Monday? No problem! Any child enrolled in other days for that week may attend the theme-launch “Special Event” on Monday with a parent or caregiver.

Extended Day Options

Early Drop off & Lunch Bunch

Families with children attending any of our Day Camps will be offered early drop off and extended day into the afternoon, to help families manage their summer schedules. Early drop off and Lunch Bunch (12:00 -1:00 PM) will be on a drop-in basis and will have a flat fee for any portion of an hour used. Our extended day option details are below.

Early Drop Off: 8:00 AM \$10.00 (Toddlers \$12.00)

Extended Day Lunch Bunch: 12:00-1:00 PM \$10.00 (Toddlers \$12.00)

After lunch we will have recess on our playground!

Afternoon Extended Day

Do you need all day care for your child this summer? We're here to help working families with their summer schedules. Children enrolled in our full day camps who need all day care can sign up for our Afternoon Extended Day from 3-5:30 p.m. The afternoon will be filled with fun activities, games and outdoor time.

Afternoon Extended day will be on a pre-registration basis and will run from the close of our full day camps at 3:00 to 5:30 PM. Cost is \$10 per hour (\$12 per hour toddlers.) Families will be charged weekly for the Afternoon Extended Day.

Post Camp

This year the Labor Day holiday falls on Monday September 7th which will bump the start of school a week so we have decided to keep the fun going with an extra week of camp The Westboro Learning Center! This week will be a post camp week. Post Camp will run on similar schedule as our regular camps. Same hours and fun, just a little more relaxed schedule to help campers get ready for the upcoming school year!

Parent/Guardian Agreement -Signature indicates I/we have read and understand the following policies:

- I/we have enclosed **full payment** for each session enrolled. Payment is non-refundable if I withdraw.
- I/we understand that our camper may not attend camp if there is still an outstanding balance. Beginning June 1, 2020, a 1.5% finance change will go into effect on all outstanding balances.
- I/we understand there is a \$25.00 fee for checks returned by the bank.
- **The children's safety is essential. Campers with special physical or sensory needs may be enrolled only after consultation with the Camp Director. I/we understand it is our responsibility to advise the director of any special concerns about our child at the time of registration.**
- I/we grant the Westboro Learning Center permission to use our child's photo to appear in learning center/camp brochures, videos or other promotional literature.
- A copy of an updated physical exam and immunization record (completed within 12 months of 6/1/2020) is required and must be on file at The Westboro Learning Center **PRIOR** to the first day of camp.
- Withdrawals/Dismissals: I/we understand that once our registration is accepted, no refunds will be made for withdrawal, dismissal, failure to attend, failure to remit final payment or incomplete attendance. I/we understand the Director reserves the right to withdraw any camper when in their judgement the camper's behavior interferes with the rights and safety of others; the smooth functioning of the group activities or violates the Camper's Code of Conduct.
